



Spiros N. Agathos, Ph.D. has been a Professor of Bioengineering at the Catholic University of Louvain, Belgium since 1993 and, since 2015, he is the Inaugural Dean of Life Sciences and Biotechnology at Yachay Tech, the first research-intensive university in Ecuador. He is an expert in Environmental and Synthetic Biotechnology and Bioengineering, with interests in biocatalyst development, bioprocess optimisation, bioreactor design and scale-up, pollutant biodegradation and site bioremediation, microbial ecogenomics, and biotechnology for sustainability. He has a PhD in biochemical engineering from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and served on the faculties of Western Ontario (Canada) and Rutgers (New Jersey, USA) and as a visiting professor in Europe and the Americas. He has published over 200 articles, 4 books and 4 patents. He has been Editor or Editorial Board member of many journals and on numerous committees for science and technology policy. He is a consultant to governments and industry, while his former students and postdocs have significant academic and industrial positions across the globe. Among his many awards, he is an elected fellow of the International Water Association (IWA), the American Institute for Medical & Biological Engineering (AIMBE) and the Society for Industrial Microbiology & Biotechnology (SIMB).
