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Daniela Smogrovicova is an Associate Professor and the Deputy Director of the Institute of Biotechnology at the Faculty of Chemical and Food Technology, Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava, Slovakia. She has been working in academia since graduating with a PhD degree in Biotechnology from the same University in 1984. Her teaching courses include Malting and Brewing, Distillery and Bio-Ethanol Production, Fundamentals of Fermentation Technology, Biochemical and Biotechnological Information. She has been supervisor of 20 Ph.D. and more than 100 Master's students. Her scientific focus is on the physiology and biochemistry of yeast under stress conditions, beer and ethanol fermentation, bio-ethanol production improvement, fermented beverage production, immobilised technologies and their industrial applications.
