Murray Moo-Young is a distinguished professor emeritus of chemical engineering at the University of Waterloo, Canada, where he supervises research on process biotechnology directed at biopharmaceuticals and biofuels, and at environmental bioremediation. A Jamaican-born Chinese-Canadian, Murray received his university degrees from the University of London (BSc, PhD) and Toronto (MSc), followed by a postdoctoral fellowship at Edinburgh. To date, his work has produced 17 books, 10 patents and over 365 journal papers. He is a consultant worldwide to industry and government. His honors include the premier awards of the Canadian Society for Chemical Engineering; and the American Chemical Society, Biochemical Technology Division. He is a fellow of the American Institute for Medical and Biological Engineering, and of the Royal Society of Canada, the highest accolade for a Canadian scholar.
